

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

SMALL GAMES OF CHANCE TOURNAMENT

- Entry fee of \$100
- Money won on tickets in each round is converted into points (the tickets have no cash value)
For example: \$370 in winning tickets equals 370 points.
- All qualifiers will be worth 50 points. After all players have opened the tickets for the round, the seal card will be opened. The players holding winning qualifiers will have additional points added to their score.
- The maximum number of players in Round 1 is 100. The top 75 scores will advance to Round 2. From Round 2, the top 60 scores will advance to Round 3. From Round 3, the top 40 scores will advance to Round 4. From Round 4, the top 20 scores will advance to the final round – Round 5 – the Money Round.
- There is a \$50 buyback option. This option may be used at any time during the tournament, but must be executed immediately following the round that the player was eliminated.
For example: A player advances from Round 1 to Round 2, but does not advance to Round 3. This player must then use the one and only buyback option at this time to play in Round 3. If this player is eliminated in another round, they are out of the tournament.
- In the event of a tie in Rounds 2 through 5, the player with the higher score in the previous round will advance to the next round or place higher in the Money Round. If there is a tie for 75th place in Round 1, both players will advance to Round 2.
- Players splitting the cost of a ticket may open tickets together. No more than two people may share a ticket. A player must be 18 years of age or older to participate in the tournament.
- When a player has opened all of the tickets for the round, please remain seated with your hand raised. A floor worker will count your points and calculate the score. You must initial next to the score received. Your initials indicate that you agree with the result of that round.
- Each round is independent. The results from a previous round will not be added together.
- Your table number is also the order used to select the ticket packs in each round. One row will be called first in Round 1, another row will be called first in Round 2, and so on.
- No outside ALCOHOL permitted. Alcohol/Beverages can be purchased from the Bedford Elks Country Club.
- Smoking is permitted outside only.
- Any problems or questions that develop during the tournament play will be discussed with the tournament committee and the decision will be fair and final.
- Instant Tickets will be on sale before the tournament begins and in between each round. Instant tickets not associated with the ticket rounds will have normal cash value.
- All proceeds from tonight's even will directly benefit Downtown Bedford's 4th of July Fireworks fund.
